

## RiverCenter: New 'ORANGE TICKET' Policy

The Rescuers: Rehearsals (5/18 & 5/19) – Performances (5/20 & 5/21)

Parents & Guardians,

The RiverCenter management has informed the Academy that all local groups renting their theatre must now use an 'Orange' Ticket. Orange Tickets will be used to pick-up your dancer each day you are at the theatre and for dropping off your dancer backstage at the 1<sup>st</sup> Ave. Stage Door before each performance (Saturday-5/20 & Sunday-5/21). Per RiverCenter policies, they will only allow **(1)** accompanying individual per dancer family at the entrance of the backstage (1<sup>st</sup> Ave. Stage Door - security desk check-in) when dropping off before each show. The same policy applies to dismissal and pick-up of your dancer, after they have exited the dressing rooms and are ready to leave. (Be sure to **Read & Review** the 'The Rescuers – Rehearsal & Performance Letter' for details on when & where to pick-up your dancer each day)

The designated 'orange' ticket holder must have the ticket with them and present it to the backstage personnel when entering from the 1st Ave. stage doors. When dancers are dismissed after performing, 'orange' ticket holders must present their ticket to personnel at the specified exit locations to retrieve their dancer.

**You must retain this ticket and present it each time you enter/exit the backstage along with pick-up locations. The RiverCenter Security Personnel will NOT allow you backstage or pick-up a dancer without an 'Orange' Ticket.**

→Backstage Volunteers will be issued a badge. The 'Orange' Ticket policy is a RiverCenter mandate, not an Academy request. To ensure the overall safety and security of our dancers, this policy is extremely important to follow and we appreciate your understanding.

**It is imperative that you keep up with this 'ORANGE' ticket for the duration of the 4-days at the RiverCenter.**
